Shelton High School has recently started implementation of the Canvas Learning Management System (LMS).

What is Canvas?

Canvas is a learning management system (LMS) that allows teachers to provide instructional support, class calendars, assignments, and resources for students in a safe online environment. For traditional face-to-face classes, Canvas is an integral part of sharing classroom updates and resources.

Canvas Use

We are confident that this resource will provide you with specific information about your student's curricula, so you have a better understanding of the work that teachers and students are doing.

What is the Parent Observer Role in Canvas?

Observers have limited permissions that allow them to see what is going on in a course and a calendar of assignments. Like students, Observers cannot view a course until it is published and the course has started. To find out more about what you can do as an observer, go to this link.

How can I view my child's courses?

Parents have two ways to view their child's course information. Please note that not all courses use all features. In addition, as we continue to build the program, features will be rolled out throughout the year:

In the web browser parents can*:

- Set notifications
- View the dashboard
- View the course information/ overview
- View but not submit assignments
- Preview and download some files
- View the Modules Page
- View the Calendar
- Communicate with the teacher

***The student's official grades will continue to be updated and maintained in Skyward.

In the **CANVAS PARENT** (blue logo) mobile appparents can:

- View courses
- View the Calendar
- View alerts
- View but not submit assignments

The Canvas **PARENT** App is available on iOS and Android mobile devices. (The Parent app has a bluelogo. There are separate apps for students and teachers.) Users will experience switching into the web browser on their mobile devices in order to view all course components. App updates are pushed out as new features are added.
