

# Shelton Kiwanis Foundation Scholarship Application

The Shelton Kiwanis Foundation awards a variety of student scholarships to graduating seniors from Shelton High School (SHS), Choice High School, Cedar High School, and/or the Running Start Program. This year's scholarship applications are due by **April 15, 2024**. Students applying through this scholarship form will be eligible for one or more of the following scholarships based on the criteria listed, as decided by the Shelton Kiwanis Foundation's Scholarship Committee:

#### **Education Scholarship**

The student has a 3.0 overall minimum GPA, has participation in school, community, and work experience, and has a commitment to enroll in a Teaching or Education related degree program.

# **General Academic Scholarship**

The student has a 3.0 overall minimum GPA, has participation in school, community, and work experience, and has a 4-year degree plan.

# **CTE (Vocational/Technical) Scholarship**

The student has a 2.0 overall minimum GPA, has participation in school, community, and work experience, has knowledge of their chosen field of study/training, and has a commitment to enroll in a Vocational/Technical program which is less than four years.

# **Nursing Scholarship**

The student has a 3.0 overall minimum GPA, has participation in school and community experiences, and has a 4-year Nursing degree plan.

- 4) A one-page document describing a) your future education and career goals and b) how the activities you listed in questions 9, 10, and/or 11 on the application form will contribute to your success in those goals.
- 5) One or two letters of recommendation.

In addition to the required materials listed above, you may also attach up to two (2) more pages with items that you feel will aid in the consideration of your application and are relevant to the scholarship criteria. This may include things like certificates, photographs, artwork, newspaper articles, etc.

You should receive an email response that your application was received within 48 hours of submission. If you do not receive an email confirmation, please call or text (805) 296-0366 before the submission deadline to ensure that your application was received and is being reviewed.
